1. Introduction

Stichting Greenlandscape was incorporated in 2016. This policy plan covers the period March 2023 to June 2026 and supersedes the previous plan. The articles of organization are available for public consultation.

2. Organisation

The foundation is governed by a board of three directors:

3. Objective

The foundation's objective is to maintain and preserve country estates in the public interest. Activities include renovation of cultural highlights (windmills, dams, historic structures), upkeep of natural environments and walking paths, restoration of heritage buildings, and financial

support to Dutch parks and nature conservation organisations. Support is provided primarily through donations to qualifying projects.

4. Projects

Each project is assessed against the foundation's primary objective before a funding decision is made. Projects may vary in duration and scale; longer projects may require multi-year reservations and phased disbursements. There is no restriction on the type of nature-oriented or heritage organisation that may apply. The board aims to visit supported projects to monitor progress.

5. Income and Expenses

Income consists primarily of donations from third parties. Interest earned on savings held by the foundation is applied to the charitable objective. All funds are directed to the foundation's activities; reservations may be made for multi-year projects or to safeguard continuity. In accordance with Article 1a(d) jo. Article 1b Uitvoeringsregeling AWR 1994, retained assets will not exceed what is reasonably necessary, and their purpose and amount will be disclosed in the annual accounts.

6. Financial Policy

The annual accounts are prepared, approved by the board, and published within six months of the close of the financial year. They disclose income by category, expenditure by project, any reservations and their purpose, and the opening and closing asset balance.

7. Remuneration of Board Members

Board members receive no remuneration. Documented out-of-pocket expenses may be reimbursed.

8. Review

This plan is valid until June 2026 and will be reviewed and renewed at that time. Material amendments require a formal board resolution.
